Understand, success means not giving up.





Daring rescue in Pitch Darkness



It is very seldom that Transport Pilots get their share of praise. Usually fighter pilots hog the limelight.

On Thursday the 24th of October, we had veteran Gp Capt Anant Bewoor (s/o COAS Gen Gopal G Bewoor) presenting to our Rotary Club "Operation Cactus" in which 32 Tpt aircrafts of IAF took part with 2650 Paratroopers & two Navy Ships. They did a coupprevention ops in Maldives in 1988. Troops & weapons cargo aircrafts AN 12s & IL 76s flew low altitude to paradrop our bravehearts from the Para Brigade in blinding darkness. Runway lights would be switched on for just 20 seconds for every landing.

Upon task accomplishment, the paratroopers had to be collected & brought back.

The entire operation was a total success without a single casualty. Not even a case of major injury. Wg Cdr (later Gp Capt) Bewoor & his team of dare devil pilots had done historic sorties in highly adverse circumstances.

As a result, the media did not report it at all !! "Koee maraa hee naheen" as the veteran pilot quipped".

Meticulous planning & execution by Pallavi & her team. "Kudos with a bang."











He chose the number 91 beneficiaries because he dedicated this in memory of his father the late Shri Hukamichand ji 'Bhau' who passed away two years ago at the age of 91. It was befitting to the life and philosophy of his father who faced many ups & downs in his life, but with his determination and hard work he bulit up a business empire from zero which has now crossed 1000 crores turnover. He wished beneficiaries all the success in their new ventures.
